In order to qualify for publication, you have to present your paper and receive a positive review.

Due to the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic the Organisers decided to adopt a remote (on-line) formula for the Conference. We hope, however, that it will be possible to hold the Conference in Krakow in personam, if the situation allows it.

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

According to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (...) ('General Regulation'), Andrzej Frycz Modrzewski Krakow University informs that:

- I.** The Controller of your personal data is Andrzej Frycz Modrzewski Krakow University based in Krakow, Gustawa Herlinga Grudzińskiego 1, 30-705 Krakow.
- II.** The University has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who may be contacted in case of any comments or questions concerning the processing of your personal data. Contact details: Gustawa Herlinga-Grudzińskiego 1, Krakow; email: iodo@afm.edu.pl.
- III.** The supplied personal data shall be processed by the Controller pursuant to Art. 6(1)(a, c and f) of the General Regulation, that is, on the basis of the consent given and for the purpose of organising and holding the Conference, as well as executing the duties and rights of the Controller stipulated by law (e.g. for the purpose of pursuing claims).
- IV.** Data provision is voluntary, but the refusal to provide it is equivalent to the lack of possibility to register for and participate in the Conference.
- V.** Your personal data may be transferred or made available to entities authorised based on the provisions of law.
- VI.** Your personal data will be stored for the period of organising and participating in the Conference, and after that time for the period and to the extent required by law for securing possible claims.
- VII.** You are entitled to: the access to your personal data and its rectification, as well as removal, restriction of processing, transfer, objection to the processing - in cases and under the conditions stipulated in the General Regulation.
- VIII.** You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
